<p>1. Create a power point <u>using all of the vocabulary words</u> from this week's list. On each slide include the vocabulary word, a synonym for the word, a sentence using the word, and a graphic that shows the meaning of the word.</p>	<p>2. Create flashcards for <u>all of the vocabulary words</u> from this week's list. On the front of each card clearly write the vocabulary word. On the back write a synonym for the word, a sentence using the word, and draw a picture showing the meaning of the word.</p>	<p>3. Write a futuristic story using <u>all of the vocabulary words</u> from your list. Your story should be at least 2 pages long. Please use descriptive language in conjunction to your vocabulary words.</p>	<p>4. Create a vocabulary word web for <u>all of the vocabulary words</u> on list this week. Each web should have the vocabulary word in the middle circle; a synonym circle, antonym circle, illustration circle, and a sentence using the word circle.</p>
<p>5. Write a humorous fiction piece using <u>all of the vocabulary words</u>. Your story should be at least 2 pages. Please include plenty of jokes and puns!</p>	<p>6. Write a non fiction article <u>using all of your vocabulary words</u>. Your story should be at least 2 pages. Please make sure to use actual facts in your piece.</p>	<p>7. Draw a mural (on paper) including illustrations of <u>all of the vocabulary words</u> for this week. Each illustration should show the meaning of the words. Make sure to hide each vocabulary word in your drawing next to the appropriate illustrations. Write 5 sentences to describe your mural using 5 of the vocabulary words.</p>	<p>8. Create a collage of magazine clippings, clipart, newspaper photos, etc. Include separate graphics for <u>all of the vocabulary words</u> for this week. Write a sentence to go along with each of the pictures to describe how they represent the vocabulary word.</p>
